NDT plays an important role at Manufacturing Stage (MSI), Pre-Service Inspection (PSI) before start of the plant as well as In-Service Inspection (ISI) during shut down of various process equipments and components in Chemical, Fertilizer, Aerospace, Thermal & Nuclear Power Plants. **Liquid Penetrant Testing (PT), Magnetic Particle Testing (MT), Radiographic Testing (RT) and Ultrasonic Testing (UT)** are the most common NDT methods widely used as an inspection tool for detecting flaws in the material. It is imperative that personnel who perform such tests are adequately trained and qualified as well as certified.

- *Certificate of participation will be issued by the chapter.*
- *Examination shall be as per IS 13805:2004 (which is as per the guidelines of ISO 9712)and will be conducted by NCB and certificates awarded to successful candidates.*

Who are eligible for attending the courses?

- The course will be useful for all those who perform or monitor NDT during manufacturing as well during in-service inspection (PSI/ISI).
- Anyone interested to enhance knowledge in NDT methods and techniques may join the class.
- Those holding Level I certificate and thereafter involved in relevant NDT field activity with an experience of 3 months in MT / PT, 9 months in ET and 18 months in UT can appear for the Level II examination in those relevant methods.
- **Those who desire to appear directly to Level II shall have a working experience of 4 months in MT/PT, 12 month in ET and 21 months in UT with minimum educational qualification as two years of Science at college or university / BSc / Diploma/Degree in Engineering.**
- **A person should have at least 220 hrs of practical work experience in RT for RTFI (Radiographic Testing -Film Interpretation) Level II examination.**
- Faculties for training are having vast and rich experience in the field of NDT and are from industrial as well as academic institutes. Course will consist of theory and practical sessions.

- *One can down load the forms for examination, course enrolment and vision check from our website www.isnt.org Vision check shall be certified by the doctor/NDE Level III.*
- *Application form, experience certificate, vision certificate and one additional copy of the photograph shall be submitted at the time of attending the course.*
